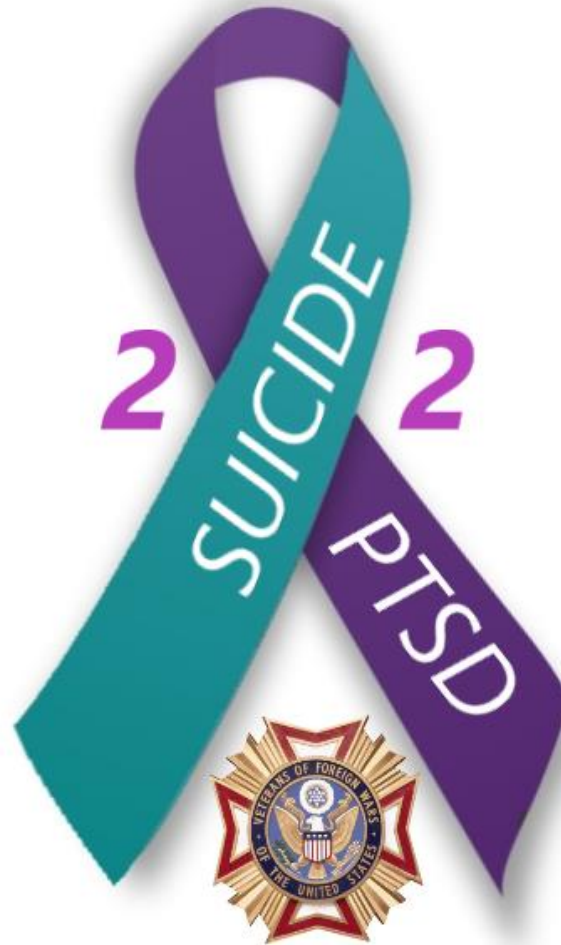

2. The VFW auxiliary is not subordinate to us. They are equal in helping veterans and their families just like the comrade side does.
3. A general report will be submitted to State Commander Archie by the 30th of each month as to how you are working with your auxiliary.
