The following has been mandated by the State Commander:

All requirements must be completed by 4:30PM, Friday April 5, 2021 to be judged for the "All-State Team" of Post Commanders and District Commanders except membership, which is required by June 30, 2021. To receive All-State award at Department Convention, membership must be 100% by April 5, 2021. If membership is 100% after April 5, 2021, awards will be given out at the next available meeting.

- Membership: 100%
- All Compliance Reports must be up to date as of April 5, 2021
- Must have participated in Veterans Military Service, Voice of Democracy, Patriot's Pen, Teachers award, and Service Officer Donations by division.
- Must have reported at least four Community Activity Reports during the year.
 Must have at least one entry in each of the lettered categories.
- One of the top four officers (Commander, Sr. Vice Commander, Jr. Vice Commander, or Quartermaster) must attend one of the training sessions, Council of Administration in September, Mid-Winter Conference in January, Council of Administration and Department Convention in June, and all District meetings for their District.
- Must have donated to the Department Veterans and Military Service according to Department All-State Divisions
 - Division 1: \$20.00 per program (\$20.00 total)
 - Division 2: \$40.00 per program (\$40.00 total)
 - Division 3: \$50.00 per program (\$50.00 total)
 - Division 4: \$75.00 per program (\$75.00 total
 - Division 5: \$100.00 per program (\$100.00 Total)
- Must have donated to the Department Voice of Democracy, Patriot's Pen and Teacher Award programs according to the Department All-State Divisions and participated by submitting a completed entry to District for each category

- Must have participated or donated to Veterans Military Service, Voice of Democracy, Patriot's Pen, Teachers award, and Service Officer Donations.
- One of the top four officers (Commander, Sr. Vice Commander, Jr. Vice Commander, or Quartermaster) must attend one of the training sessions, Council of Administration in September, Mid-Winter Conference in January, Council of Administration and Department Convention in June.
- Any District that opens a new post will be awarded All-State.
